***FRIDAY, June 14: AFTERNOON SHOW DRESS REHEARSAL- 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. Drop off/check in: 8:15 am. (Bring packed meal and large T-shirt cover up for outdoor LUNCH break). Lunch break will take place <u>AT THE AUDITORIUM. DANCERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES DURING DRESS REHEARSAL!</u>

***FRIDAY, June 14 EVENING SHOW DRESS REHEARSAL - 3:00 – 7:00 p.m. Drop off/check in: 2:15 am.(Bring packed meal and large T-shirt cover up for outdoor dinner break). Dinner break will take place <u>AT THE AUDITORIUM</u>. <u>DANCERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES DURING DRESS REHEARSAL!</u>

RECITAL - SATURDAY, JUNE 15: PERFORMANCE ARRIVAL TIME: Students are to arrive 45 minutes prior to performance time wearing first costume needed, with hair in a bun (unless otherwise instructed) and make up applied for both rehearsal and performances. Afternoon show starts at 1:00, Evening show starts at 6:00. ALL DANCERS MUST ENTER THE BACKSTAGE ENTRANCE FOR DRESS REHEARSAL AND PERFORMANCE. Follow the sidewalk on the south side (left) of the auditorium around to the back door entrance. STUDENTS PERFORMING IN BOTH SHOWS must leave immediately after the afternoon performance and return at 5:15. Students are not to be left unattended between dress rehearsal or performances. All staff and adult helpers will be leaving the auditorium immediately at the conclusion of morning dress rehearsal and the afternoon show for dinner break.

RULES TO BE OBSERVED BY ALL:

- 1. Spectators are **NOT ALLOWED** at dress rehearsal.
- 2. <u>Parents are NOT allowed to remain in the dressing rooms during rehearsal or performance</u>. Due to overcrowding, <u>ONLY designated</u> helpers are allowed in the rooms with students during rehearsal/performance. We thank you for your cooperation.
 - 3. FOOD IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE DRESSING ROOM AT ANY TIME. Water only please.
 - 4. GLITTER SPRAY (FOR BODY OR HAIR) IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE DRESSING ROOMS
- 5. Students are NOT ALLOWED to be in the auditorium OR LOBBY at any time during the performance dressed in costumes. Students must remain in the dressing rooms at all times during dress rehearsal and performance.

WHAT TO BRING: Students should bring the following items to dress rehearsal and performance: Safety pins, lots of bob-pins, hair spray and gel, make up, all costumes, shoes and accessories. Please be SURE to print your name on all shoes, costumes and accessories!

COSTUMES should be in a zipped garment bag with name label on front. DRESSING ROOM PROCEDURE: All dressing rooms will have student names and assigned helpers posted on the entrance doors. Locate your child's name and bring child to helper with all items needed for performance. Please give your cell phone number to assigned helper in case of emergency. Return to pick them up at the conclusion of rehearsal or performance. Students will occupy the same dressing room for both dress rehearsal and performance dates. All costumes and belongings must be taken home after dress rehearsals & performance. PLEASE help us clean up the dressing rooms after each use. Thank you!

COSTUMES & MAKE UP

- 1. Please layer tights! If you are required to wear both pink and tan tights, please wear the color required in your first dance on top of the other. This will make changing much quicker and easier!
- 2. All hats must have elastic attached to go under the chin! Cover with foundation make up to match skin. Use multiple bobby pins to attach headpieces securely.
- 3. Panties are NOT to be worn under costumes! Nude camisole leotards are allowed. If a student MUST wear panties because they are extremely self-conscious, please purchase NUDE colored underwear. Also, NO GUM, JEWELRY OR NAILPOLISH!!!!
 - 4. All costume pieces, shoes and accessories must be labeled clearly with your name!
- 4. Hair is to be worn in a bun. Please see hair chart in waiting area for location of the bun. Secure with lots of gel, hairspray and secured with bob pins AND hair net. ANY exception to this will be announced specifically by the teacher or listed on the hair/make-up chart in the studio. NO BANGS OR FLYAWAYS!!!!
- 5. Make up: All Pre-school and Jr. classes classes: Blue eye shadow, black mascara, foundation, blush. See make-up chart for lipstick color.
 - 6.. Make up: ALL other classes: See make-up chart in studio.
